Registrants' Responsibility to Notify the College of Any Change to Registration Information

Article 57--Notification of change of registration information--under the CLPNBC Bylaws, states that:

A registrant must immediately notify the Registrar of any change of address, name, or any other registration information previously provided to the Registrar.

It is a violation of the Bylaws, article 57, not to inform the College of any change in address, name, or any other change in registration information. Every registrant is responsible to notify the College as soon as possible. Failure to notify the College may result in the delay of important information being sent from the College, such as registration renewal forms, continuing competency requests, etc. Such delays can lead to a situation where a Registrant may be working without proper licensure.
